Tom is doing the 941 Forms. He has completed the 2013 forms. He still needs the bank statement from Mutual Bank.


Poor Relief was discussed. The pay scale was changed from 2013 to 2014. The pay scale for the Board and the Trustee will be voted on.

The next meeting will be February 4, 2014.


Jim made a motion for adjournment and the meeting adjourned at 8:57 P.M.
