

March 6, 2018

The Advisory Board Meeting for Seemax Township was called to order at 6:00pm. Board members present were Chairman, Jim Pepples, Secretary, Leta Johnson, Delois Schooker, and Trustee Teresa McClanahan. Refer to sign in sheet for guests.

Leta Johnson read the secretary's report. Delois Schooker made a motion to accept as read. The motion passed 3-0.

The report from the fire Territory was given by Dave Cherrone. He told that the fire Department received a large enough grant to purchase 6 automatic chest compression devices enough for one in each engine.

Dave will be checking on the community building to see what the proper number of people should be in the large room.

The Trustee reported that the septic tank had been pumped and should be good for 2 years. Tom and Teresa McClanahan gave a slide presentation on the Cripe Wittu and Dunkard Cemeteries. Work needs to be done in each cemetery. At Cripe Wittu someone needs to go to the County City Building and get the plot. We need to know Meijer's property line. Very few graves are marked because the cemetery is so old and the stones are either broken or destroyed. At the Dunkard cemetery on Adams Road the fence either needs

fixed or replaced. Dead limbs need to be picked up.
A committee meeting has not been scheduled yet.
Also showed slides on work that needs to be done
ⁱⁿ the flower beds out in front of the Community
Building. The play ground area needs to be
cleared and a sign put up referring to the park.
The Eave Trough has been destroyed on the North
side of the building. Waiting on Insurance Company
Question on insulating the building. Tom McClanahan
said there is no egress to insulate under the roof.
The Bell Tower only goes into the Bell Tower not
into the crawl space
