Meeting called to order 6:08 pm by chairman McClanahan. Pledge of allegiance said by all followed by a moment of silence for those who have passed and service members. Meetings are live streamed
Roll call by secretary McNeil. Chair McClanahan present, board member Monterrosa, secretary McNeil present, trustee Robinson present. All present.

February 2026 minutes read by secretary McNeil. Motion by chair McClanahan to accept Feb. 17th 2026 minutes as read. So moved by board member Monterrosa. Seconded by secretary McNeil

January 2026 financials read by trustee Robinson. Concerns asked and answered. Motion by chair McClanahan to approve January 2026 financial as read. So moved by board member Monterrosa,

Tree estimates presented by trustee Robinson. Extended discussion on tree work estimates for center grounds including Cripe Witter and Portage Prairie cemeteries. Board will evaluate needed tree work at these sites. Tree removal/trimming a top priority and additional bids possible. 2) playground equipment replacement discussed. Board member to check what equipment Camp Millhouse has and offered other playground equipment organization's names. Grant possible to help with equipment cost.

Hall Report presented by deputy trustee Brown. Rentals down from last year with 1st Quarter at \$5700. Utilities stable. Summer rentals usually should pick up revenue.


New Business. Trustee Robinson explained the incorrect installation by Forte waterproofing. Forte has not responded to calls. Payment being withheld. Clay fire territory expansion passed. Penn and Osceola fire services will merge with Clay fire expansion in 2027. Thus joining German, Roseland, Indian Village and Harris townships.

Hearing of Visitors: Concern on buying expensive new playground equipment and lack of use. SB1 bill discussed. Lack of public information given on the fire territory expansion expressed. Concern expressed on centers' address used by Kingdom Business and of trustee's name on electronic sign.


Good of the Township: Board member felt the passing of the Clay expansion a good thing. Reminder taxes due April 15th. Clarification of capital improvement plan impacting township monies and the state road improvement fund.
