

GERMAN TOWNSHIP ADVISORY BOARD MEETING

June 8th, 2026

Meeting called to order 5:00 pm by chairman McClanahan. Pledge of allegiance said by all followed by a moment of silence for those who have passed and service members. Meetings are live streamed

Roll call by secretary McNeil. Chair McClanahan present, board member Monterrosa present, secretary McNeil present, trustee Robinson present. All present.

May 2026 minutes read by secretary McNeil. Motion by board member Monterrosa to accept May 18th minutes as read with the amendment that "chair McClanahan indicates a willingness to entertain a motion to table the playground equipment estimate to a later date", seconded by secretary McNeil. Chair McClanahan requests a motion to accept May 18 minutes as read with correction. Board member Monterrosa moved the motion, seconded by secretary McNeil. Ayes have it. The motion carried.

May 2026 Financials read by trustee Robinson. Concerns asked and answered. Chair McClanahan entertains a motion to accept May 2026 financials as read. Board member Monterrosa moved the motion, seconded by secretary McNeil. The ayes have it. Motion carried.

Reviewing Pavilion estimates. Lengthy board discussion on replacing pavilion and new concrete work. Motion by board member Monterrosa to approve the budgeted proposal including new concrete by Home Works Construction estimate amount of \$88,849.56. Concerns asked and answered. Chair McClanahan clarified the motion, on the floor, to accept Home Works estimate of \$88,849.56, seconded by secretary McNeil. The ayes have it. Motion carried.

Reviewing Playground equipment estimate. Cost of playground equipment, edging and playground mulch discussed. Playground grant and county assistance to be pursued. Motion by board member Monterrosa to approve an expenditure with landscape structure up to \$25,000 recognizing there is \$85,000 in the budget. Chair McClanahan clarified the motion, on the floor, for recreational equipment, playground mulch and edging up to \$25,000. Seconded by secretary McNeil. The ayes have it. Motion carried.

Spring Event : Trustee reported Spring Event had a good turnout. Food provided by Hacienda.

Hall Report: Deputy trustee Brown reported May revenue of \$1450. Announced church left as of May 31st due to a space issue. A revenue loss of over \$9,000 yearly. Church rented since July 2022 Revenue expectation will be diminished

New Business: A picnic on July 15 is being planned.

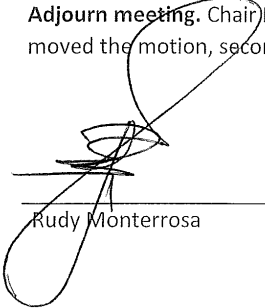
Hearing of Visitors: Question on withheld May supplemental LIT monies. Trustee Robinson stated May "supplemental" LIT payment withheld due to tax levies. The "monthly" LIT and COIT monies are being received. Comment on replacement of damaged pavilion and concrete is premature, not knowing the effect of SB1 bill on townships. Concerns on unfinished Forte Waterproofing work.

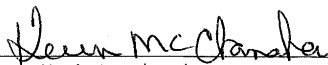
